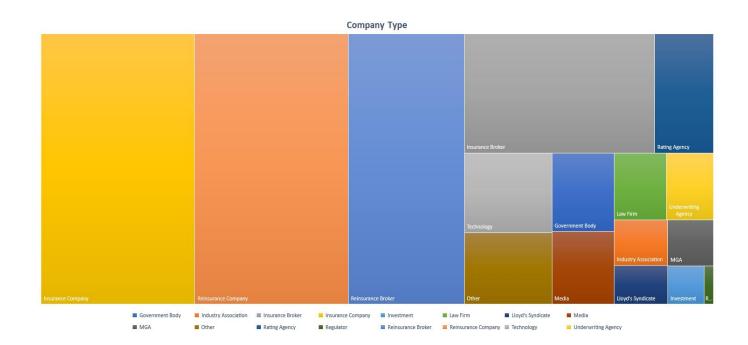
You will also find the InsurTech Demo Zone located in the main Network Hall along with Exhibitor Row and the central Barista service Coffee Bar.

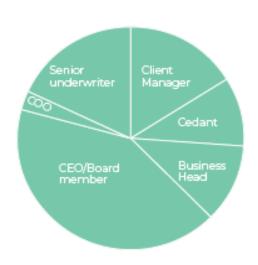
#### **DWIC HONOURS 2020**

# YOUNG MENA INSURANCE PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR

This award recognises a young insurance professional who has demonstrated outstanding commitment, achievement and passion in the MENA insurance industry during 2018/2019. The candidate must be under 35 years of age at 31 December 2019 and have more than three years of experience in the industry.

#### **ENTRY**

This award should be self-nominated and written by the nominee with a supporting statement from a line manager.

#### MENA RISK MANAGER OF THE YEAR

This category is open to any individual who currently has responsibility for corporate risk and/or insurance management, and whose work during 2018/9 has made a significant difference to his or her organisation or the wider risk management community. The judges are looking for evidence of the individual's strategic and operational thinking, effective leadership and planning, excellent communication skills and demonstrable results. The contribution and result should preferably be innovative as well as excellent.

#### **ENTRY**

This award should be self-nominated and written by the nominee with a supporting statement from a line manager.

#### THE MENA CEOS' CEO OF THE YEAR

This award is voted for by CEOs of the largest reinsurers, insurers and brokers in the MENA region. We ask them to choose their 'first among equals', to select the CEO whom they most admire in the region. Your online nomination should be accompanied by a testimonial – a summary of why exceptional leadership and outstanding achievements for the period 2018/2019 make the CEO worthy of the award.

### **ENTRY**

You must be a CEO to make a nomination. Please submit your nomination online. Please give the name of the CEO and their company name plus a testimonial. There may be multiple awards given in this category. Once nominations have been received, an online vote will commence on 1 November 2019.

#### MENA LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD
